Graduates of all programs in medical imaging have multiple pathways to registry including American Registry for Diagnostic Medical Sonography (ARDMS), Cardiovascular Credentialing International (CCI), American Registry of Radiologic Technologists (ARRT), and programmatically approved by the American Registry of Magnetic Resonance Imaging Technologists (ARMRIT).
