

WCUI TECHNOLOGY REQUIREMENTS

WCUI School of Medical Imaging and Nursing has adapted our programs to include online learning options. To ensure a smooth learning experience, students who are enrolled in at least one online course must:

STEP ONE:

- Complete a computer and internet speed assessment to ensure technology minimums are met to attend online courses.
 - Test download speed (minimum of 1.5 Mbps) on speedtest.net

STEP TWO:

 Complete an online introductory course to demonstrate the ability to navigate online course work. The introductory course will be offered through either a third-party course such as "LaunchPad" or a WCUI produced training course offered through Canvas.

COMPUTER REQUIREMENTS:


- Laptop and/or desktop equipped with Windows or Mac OS software.
 - Tablets (iPad, chromebooks, etc.) do not meet the minimum hardware requirements and are not a viable substitute for your primary laptop or desktop).
 - Students may use any model of PC or Mac as long as it meets the WCUI Computer Requirements.
- Processor: Minimum 1.5 GHz; Recommended 2GHz or more.
- Ethernet connection (LAN) OR a wireless adapter (Wi-Fi).
- Hard Drive: Minimum 30 GB; Recommended 120 GB or more available.
- Memory (RAM): Minimum 4 GB; Recommended 8 GB or above.
- Sound card w/speakers.
- Some classes require a camera and microphone.

HOW TO CHECK YOUR PC AND MAC


This guide will assist you in determining if your PC or Mac fits the WCUI Computer Requirements on the front of this page.

PC

- 1. Go to the START button & type in "System Information" into the search bar
- 2. Select "System Information" at the top of your search



3. Now you can see a list of details about your PC such as Processor, Physical Memory (RAM) & compare it to the WCUI Computer Requirements



MAC

- 1. Click the Apple logo in the top left corner of your screen
- 2. Select "About this Mac"
